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Keyrings — great idea to help you find your keys in the bottom of your bag

Miniature Cushions



Materials

- 3" square outer fabric
- 3" square lining fabric
- 6" 'Mother's Day' ribbon
- Handful of toy stuffing
- Hemline rectangular ring

Haberdashery items

- Iron-away marker pen
- Quilters ruler,
- Rotary cutter/scissors
- Iron



Making the cushion keyring

Using the iron-away marker pen, draw a straight or diagonal line 2" across the outer fabric. Pin the 'Mother's Day' ribbon along the line, sew in place using 1.6mm stitches along the top and bottom of the ribbon. Snip away excess ribbon.



Take the two squares of fabric, and sew RST, all the way around using $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance – leave a 1" gap in the top right-hand corner. Turn right side out and press.



Thread the remaining ribbon through the metal ring. Stuff the mini cushion, and poke the ribbon inside



Tuck raw edges of the corner inside and sew 1/8" all the way around the cushion.

Your miniature Mother's Day cushion keyring is complete
