Block 8 – 16” x 16” finished size (16 ½ x 16 ½” unfinished)

Fabric requirements:

Two 9" squares from fabric 3

One 9 ¼" square from fabric 1

One 9 ¼" square from fabric 2

One 9 ¼" square from fabric 4

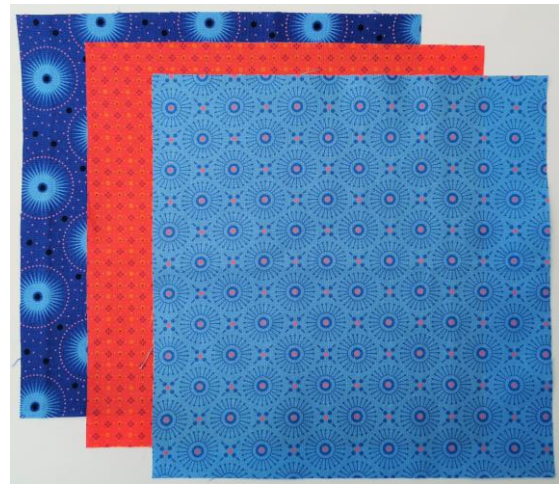
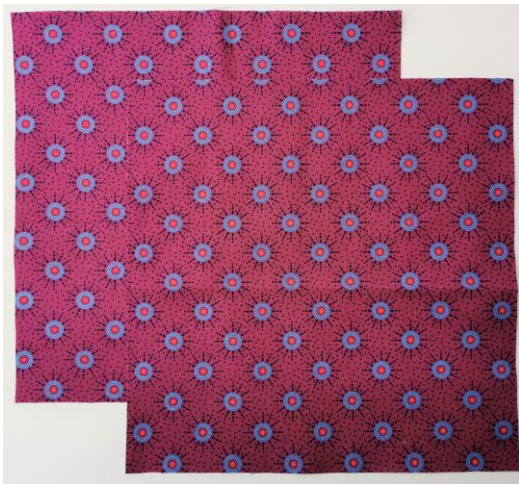
Haberdashery Items

Basic Sewing supplies

Quilting ruler, rotary cutter/scissors

cutting mat

Iron, friction fabric pen

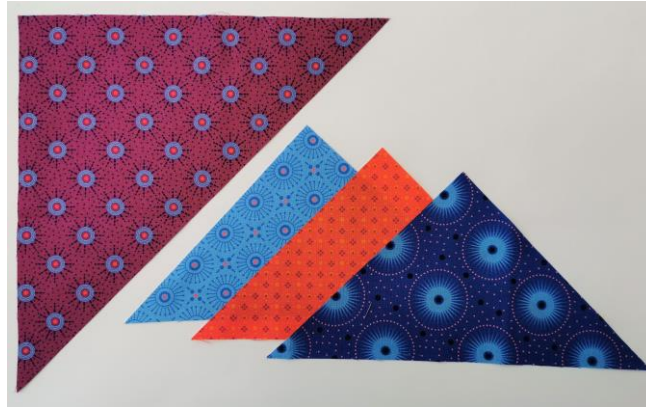


Let's get sewing...

Cut the two 9" squares in half along the diagonal

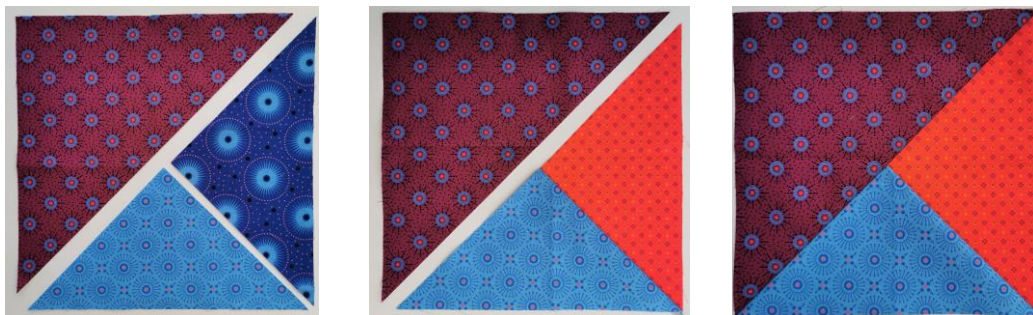
Cut the 9 ¼" square from fabric 1 twice, along each diagonal.

(for more accurate cutting, do not move the fabric between cuts)



Cut the 9 ¼" squares from fabric 2 and 4, in half along the diagonal. (put spare triangle to one side). Fold the big triangle in half and finger press to show middle, cut along this pressed line.

Sew blocks together as shown below



Press seams towards the darker fabric

Trim blocks to 8 ½" x 8 ½" if needed

Sew the top two blocks together and press to the left, repeat for the bottom two block and press to the right. Nest centre seams and sew together to complete your block, press seams open.

Block 8 is complete – Congratulation
