

Fabric Envelopes...

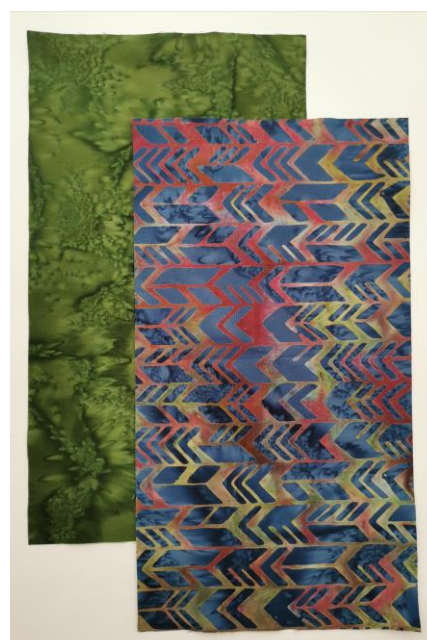
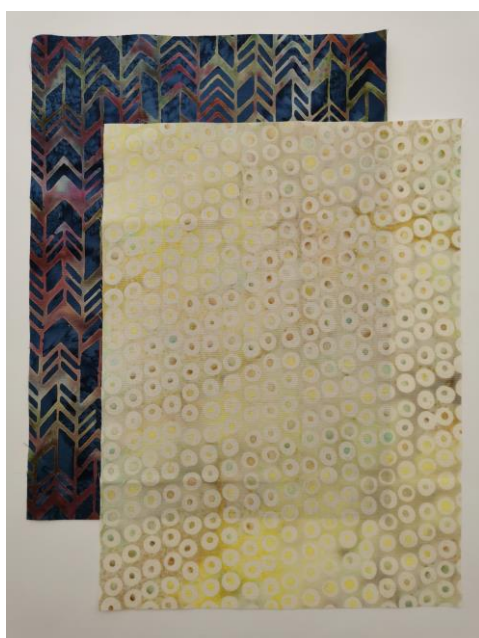
Follow this tutorial, to make your own fabric envelopes, perfect for gift vouchers or a special note, fabrics are available from '[Island Batik](#)'.

Please read through all the instructions before starting your project

Choose your gorgeous fabrics, you will need two pieces for each envelope (outer and lining)

Large envelope cut 11" x 8" piece (X2)

Small envelope cut 11" x 6" piece (X2)



Finished sizes; 7 ½" x 4 ¼" Large. 5 ½" x 3 ½" - small

Haberdashery items

- Quilters ruler, rotary cutter/scissors
- Iron
- Cutting mat
- Basic sewing supplies
- Frixtion fabric pen
- Clover snag repair needles

Lets get sewing...

Fold the outer fabric in half along the shortest edge and mark 9 ½" from the bottom corner (for large envelope and 8" for smaller envelope), cut a diagonal from the mark to the centre join. Open and press. Repeat with lining pieces.



Lay large pieces RST and sew ¼" all the way round, leaving a 3" gap across the bottom edge for turning. Repeat with the smaller envelope pieces.

Snip excess from top corner on smaller envelope, and bottom corners on both.



Turn right side out through the gap, and press.

Press raw edges inside, and sew 1/8" along the bottom edge, on both envelopes.

Use Clover – snag repair needles for sewing in all your threads



Take large envelope, and with right side faced down, fold the bottom edge up by 3 ½", press. Fold the top over 2 ½" and press (measured from tip).

For smaller envelope, fold up 3 ½" from bottom, and fold top over 3 ¼", press.



Add stitch detail along the top edge point.

With bottom edge folded up, sew 1/8" down one side, along the bottom and back up the other side. Repeat for smaller envelope.

Add your vouchers ...

These envelopes could also be personalised with an initial or symbol.
